

Depositing Snow in the Township Right-of-Way

It is unlawful for anyone to deposit any snow or ice in a public road right-of-way or to otherwise obstruct a public road. Minn. Stat. §§ 160.27, subd. 5(a)(1); 169.42, subd. 1. Depositing snow or ice in a road also increases snowplowing costs, creates a potential public safety hazard, and could damage equipment.

Note that the right-of-way extends 33 feet from either side of the center line of the road.

Inquiries regarding this notice should be directed to the Brandon Township Clerk. Please inform your commercial snow plow service (if you use one) of this law and that fines may be imposed.
